Óbuda University!



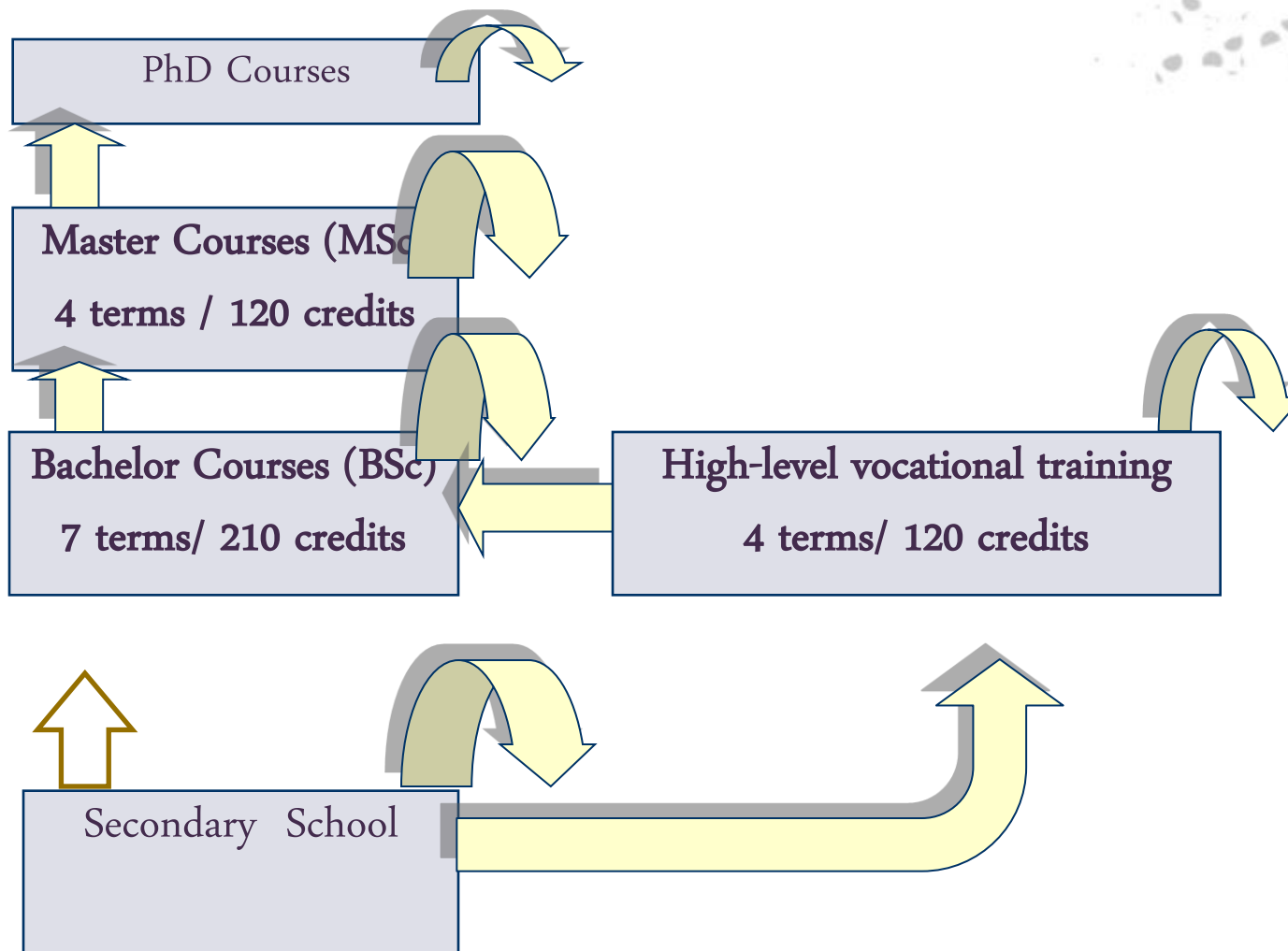

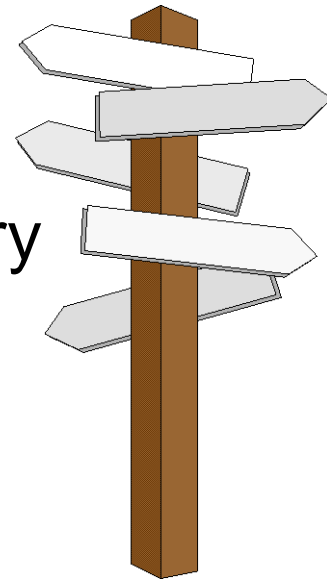

2. Mutual support of the publication of scientific works in their universities' journals, and mutual support of Acta Graphica as a peer-reviewed high quality scientific journal and the thematic shifting of the Journal of Graphic Engineering and Design towards professional and design areas.

3. Elaboration of an English language study program, which can be mutually accepted as a program for exchange students.

Collaboration program

4. To join the SEE program as a financial support for the study project and evaluate the possibilities of a joint application for the Erasmus Mundus project.
5. Joint research projects.
6. To join and develop the FESPA education project.
